Your custom bleaching trays will be ready for you to pick up from our office in only a couple of days. We will provide you with a bleaching gel which you will place inside the bleaching trays before placing them into your mouth. With less than five minutes of wear each day, our special bleaching agent causes stains to vanish in very short period time without causing harm to tooth structure or existing dental work. Once the desired shade of your teeth is obtained, only occasional treatment is necessary in order to maintain your new smile.

Dental bleaching is able to remove many tooth discolorations and improve your smile. Staining, aging, or chemical damage to teeth are the cause of many tooth discolorations. Using the latest in dental bleaching technology, we are able to offer a safe, fast working bleaching technique to provide you with a whiter smile. Please be aware that crowns or veneers may be the only resolution in extreme cases of tooth discoloration.

After the the desired brightness of your teeth is obtained, periodically using the bleaching materials will help maintain your new smile.
